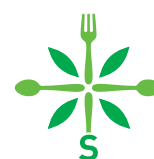

2020 was a record-breaking year for South Michigan Food Bank! Because of the collaboration between our volunteers, donors, partners, and staff, we distributed over 14.5 million pounds of food across eight counties – a 60% increase from 2019. How were we able to accomplish so much together in such a difficult time?

We adapted:

- We knew we must stay open AND keep people safe in order to feed more people than ever before.
- We shifted our distribution model. For the first time ever, we offered drive-thru, contact-less food pick-ups. This kept our clients, volunteers, and staff safe by providing room for social distancing.

Amidst the uncertainty of 2020, the people of South Michigan remained confident they could rely on their food bank – South Michigan Food Bank. Thank you for doing your part to help us feed more people than ever before! We look forward to the exciting days ahead as we continue our mission to end hunger across South Michigan.
